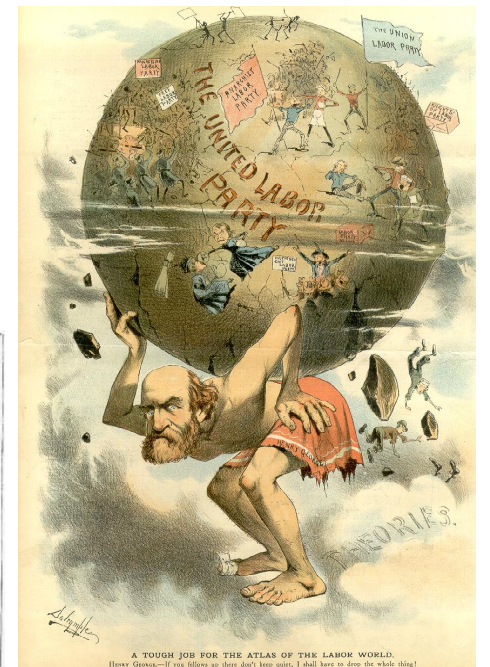
America Becomes Pro-Labor when Labor Takes On Monopoly Privilege
